FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Dear Friends

During November we were encouraged to undertake the "Cathedral Prayer Walk" following in the footsteps of those who have gone before us. The Prayer Walk is an opportunity to take stock - to pause for a moment and look around us to see the beauty that surrounds us and to look up.

Today, the feast day of Christ the King is the last Sunday of the Church year - it is an opportunity to reflect on the year that has been - to hand over the pain and sadness to Christ our King and to thank Him for the blessings. Even those who have had a year where suffering was present will still be able to see the blessings - the light of Christ shining through.

As a community we reflect on our journey together in faith - we reflect upon our shared relationship with God and how we have grown in our relationship over the last year. Maybe an appropriate question would be to ask how we have recognised God in our lives this year? How we have brought others closer to God by our words and actions? Who is God for us in our everyday messiness and toil?

The Prayer Walk - allows us to reflect back on our baptism, it highlights the role of the Saints in our history and tradition, it reminds us of the biblical stories that continue to guide our path, it leads us to the most sacred - the Blessed Sacrament Chapel where we light a candle remembering our loved ones - truly the light of Christ shining from their memory upon us.

We have several icons in our Churches - this year we have the new icon of St Patrick - recently I asked some of the school-children what they think of when they think of an icon - they spoke about football players and musicians - we need to reclaim the 'iconic' nature of the Saints - we need to re-assess who we see as our inspiration and guide on life's journey towards our King.

As a King, Jesus leads us in justice, truth and hope towards a better tomorrow - Jesus leads us to a new and better life however sometimes we fail to follow him. As we end our Church year let us reflect on how we can more closely follow God's plan for our lives and how we can inspire others to renew their relationship with God.

150th Year since the Dedication of the Cathedral

This week we have installed a new shrine in the Cathedral which includes the 'Icon' of St Patrick which was commissioned for the 150th Anniversary of the Cathedral's dedication. Do drop in and say a prayer and light a candle.
