Dear Friends.

This Sunday Pope Francis asks that we reflect on the Word of God. The scriptures are living words that speak to every generation and time and are precious in that we reverence the Bible as a gift from God.

This Sunday also falls within Christian Unity Week, a week in the year when we celebrate other Christian traditions and those aspects which unite us, mindful always that it is Jesus Christ who ultimately unites us as Christians. It is noteworthy that the scriptures, the Word of God, is the true unifier between Christians. Often we fail to recognise God's voice in the midst of war and division and bitterness and violence however God's voice is always there. We must be mindful not to allow the divisions of humanity to blur our shared vision of God.

Maybe today you might consider taking the bulletin home and identify the areas of similarity between the Old and New Testament, identify why the psalm is chosen to bridge these two aspects. Today is an opportunity to renew your relationship with Jesus by deciding to read His Word more often this year.
