# Dear Friends.

Last week I spent some days in Rome and while there I was so blessed to celebrate Mass in St Peter's Basilica in the Irish Chapel. I prayed for the intentions of parishioners and friends and for a renewal of the faith in Ireland. I am conscious of this week's Feast of St Brigid, which this year marks 1500 years since her death. Though very much associated with Kildare, St Brigid was born in Faughart, Co Louth and acts as a model of faith right up to today.

St Brigid's legacy of faith like St Patrick and many of the Irish Saints, rests in its simplicity - she communicated the Good News with 'weeds' reeds/rushes bound into a shape to represent the cross. Whatever troubles you carry with you today they represent your cross. Like St Brigid, you too can hand on the greatest gift of all - the gift of faith through your faithful witness to your relationship with God.

St Brigid had courage and determination - she challenged the King of Leinster who gave her the land of Kildare to build her monastery. Our country and our world needs courage like St Brigid's. We need courageous leaders willing to stand up for their beliefs and bear witness to God's presence - like St Brigid we are all called to trust God's providence and witness to His goodness. This week please do join us for our celebrations marking St Brigid and please do pray that our country will once more witness courageously to the glory of the Cross of Jesus.
