Some years ago, a man spoke to me and told me that he would like to print the 10 commandments on little cards to hand them out to people - I was initially dismissive, suggesting that everyone knows them already! As I have gotten older I realise that the gift of faith is not well received by everyone - indeed some people are hostile towards the faith and towards any sense of God or a moral compass.

The live and let live mentality persists - the idea that sin is relative persists. We have turned into a people who believe we are stronger than God and yet today's second reading reminds us that 'even God's weakness is stronger than human strength'.

As we reflect on the Gospel today let us place ourselves in the story, let us hear Jesus' words as He encourages us to remain strong in faith remembering that Jesus' body was destroyed on Good Friday but the story does not end there - rather we look to Easter Sunday. We are an Easter people - even in this season of Lent we are called to be people of hope and joy. Our Lenten observance is meant to build us up and sustain us towards a closer relationship with Jesus. Even if you have broken your Lenten promise - today is the perfect day to restart it, if you haven't yet begun something for Lent, why not start it today.

Maybe you could learn the 'Commandments or teach them to a young person - truly handing on the gift of faith.
