Dear Friends,

One of my favourite quotes from the diary of St Faustina is God's words "My mercy is greater than your sins and those of the whole world... for you I descended from Heaven to Earth.. I let my heart be pierced with a lance thus opening wide the source of mercy for you". In these words we come to understand the magnitude of Easter - the feast that truly rocked the world, changing how we live and die.
