Dear Friends,

This week's Gospel issues a strong warning to each of us to stand ready to meet the Lord. As Jesus speaks of the darkness that 'will' come over the world it is perhaps easy to cast our minds to the darkness of war and division that has currently beset the world. Did we ever think that after the atrocities of the 20th Century that we would be back to the violence and extreme rhetoric that we live with now, I don't believe that I did. I thought that the world and its leaders would learn from the mistakes of the past.

Each one of us have a responsibility to bring God's healing message to our world each of us as disciples are called to be missionaries in our own community, our homes and within our families. We are called to proclaim the message of peace with the joy that our hope from God brings us. You and I, by virtue of our baptism have a mission from God to pass on the 'Gift of Faith'. Often faith is seen in terms of 'chores' we have to do - we are called to change the language - faith is not a chore, a life giving and fulfilling relationship with Jesus is a gift - but like all gifts it must be accepted and put into action for it to be of real benefit.

As a faith community, we have a responsibility to reach out to those on the margins those outside the Church and to invite them in, this is often a challenge however I want to thank all those in the parish who are engaged in outreach - there are many people who take seriously the final words of the Mass "Go forth, to love and serve the Lord" and who continue to serve in the community. Our current food appeal is one such example where we have an opportunity to come together and do good for others in Jesus' name - thank you to everyone who will support this appeal and all our outreach opportunities.
