In November we Remember!

Dear Friends.

November is the month of the Holy Souls - a period where we are particularly aware of those who have gone before us and the month where we pray that their souls are in the safe embrace of God.

Each of us have a different view of what heaven looks like - each of us have a different image of God in our hearts. The Gospel this weekend reminds us of what Jesus describes as the first of all the commandments - Jesus speaks of the commandments of love. Each of us who have lost loved ones are acutely aware of the pain that grief can cause - grief is the price we pay for love! but we also know that the love we share with one another is a reflection of the love God has for each of us. We entrust our loved ones into God's care remembering that God is love. Pope Francis reminded us in his 2016 book that 'the name of God is Mercy'.

This month as we remember our loved ones let us reflect on the mercy of God and the beauty of Heaven in the knowledge that God has called our loved ones in love to their eternal homeland. We are mindful that as followers of Jesus we are not exempt from pain and grief but rather we live our grief in hope - and Christian Hope comes from the promise of the Resurrection. Jesus said "I am the Resurrection and the Life, anyone who believes in me will live" and we live in this promise.

Plenary Indulgences can be gained from visiting the cemetery, going to confession, attending Mass and praying for the Popes intentions during these days.
