Dear Friends,

This weekend marks the birth of the Church, Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after the solemn festival of Easter and marks the end of the Easter Season within the Church. While every Sunday is a celebration of Jesus' Resurrection these days are special moments to reflect on how this universal transformation has impacted on our own lives. Often in today's busy and noisy world we tend to overlook the impact on our lives of Jesus's life, death and resurrection.

This week has been another powerful week for the Sacramental life of our parish, with Fr Giacomo's ordination and the celebrations of Confirmation we really have experienced great joy.
