Dear Friends,

"Pray continually and never lose heart" these words from today's Gospel are a reminder that we can unite with God regardless of what we are doing in our everyday life. Whether we are at home, at work, at school or in our community we can be witnesses of the Good News in our words and our actions. In these simple words we are also reminded of the need to trust God - we must never lose heart because all our prayers are answered 'in God's time' and more importantly all are prayers are heard.

Over the last week I have been reminding people of the need to be thankful - the fragile peace in the Holy Land, all the little miracles in our own lives are all reminders to us that God hears and responds to our prayer, often not in the way that we demand but always in ways that teaches us to trust in His great plan for us. Suffering and pain are often part of life's journey and this can be difficult for us to understand, however we must know that even in the darkness of life God's light continues to illumine our hearts, if we let it.

Over these days we are called to reflect on our lives, on the hurts that we carry and the darkness that we feel and to invite Jesus to heal us, to bring about a sense of his presence in the midst of the troubles that we face and to ensure that we never lose heart.

These past weeks in our parish have seen some important "green shoots" as we have renewed our chaplaincies and begun some important outreach to our young people through our new youth team headed up by Ryan McParland. We are planning to arrange a youth centred Mass in the next few weeks that will encourage our young adults to join (keep an eye out) - it can be difficult for us when we see fewer young people attending church however we each have a role to play in extending the invitation - our young adults are often searching for something, we know that when we deepen our relationship with our loving God, who loves us unconditionally - that search is over, lets encourage our young to engage in this journey.


