This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, the Universal King. This year is especially significant, as it marks the 100th anniversary of the feast's institution by Pope Pius XI in 1925.

In the encyclical that introduced this celebration, Pope Pius XI reminded Catholics of the call to be "a people who seek the peace of Christ in the Kingdom of Christ." The feast was established in connection with the anniversary of the Nicene Creed—now 1700 years old-which proclaims a Kingdom of God that has no end. In the aftermath of World War I, the world was shaken: atheism was on the rise, nationalism was intensifying, and global stability was fragile. In many ways, we find ourselves again in a world that needs to refocus on the universality of Christ's kingship. We live under His reign, and we place our trust in His plan.

As we enter the final week of the Church year, let us pause to look back with gratitude for the blessings, the opportunities, the moments of joy, and for the community that has supported one another through sorrow and challenge. As we prepare for the beginning of Advent and a new liturgical year, let us commit ourselves to shaping a brighter tomorrow for our families, our community, and our world. And let us rely on God's grace as we set out on this renewed journey together.
