Dear Friends,

This weekend's readings are focused on "humility in prayer". The first reading from Ecclesiasticus includes that powerful line 'the humble man's prayers pierces the clouds' the psalm reminds us that the Lord hears the cry of the poor & the Gospel speaks of the Tax Collector who cries out in humble petition for God to be 'merciful to me, a sinner'.

In St Paul's letter to Timothy which we are well familiar with from funeral liturgies we are reminded of the importance of the virtue of humility in 'running the race to the finish, fighting the good fight and keeping the faith'. As we enter the month of November - the month of the Holy Souls' we are all challenged to look forward to what our legacy's will be - have we walked humbly with God and done our best to create a better world, have we fought hard for justice and fairness in our dealings with others, have we kept a strong relationship with Jesus in faith.

Ultimately this weekend we are asked if we recognise God in our everyday lives, is God part of our everyday or not ... in asking whether we recognise God in the world around us and the people we journey with we are also challenged as to whether God would recognise us - have we a lived relationship with God, do we trust Him, do we reach out to him in prayer and petition? Do we live our lives in a way that prepares us to worship God forever in Heaven? These are deep and important questions but deeply important questions for us also.


