Today we celebrate the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica — the Pope's Cathedral in Rome and the Mother Church of the Universal Church. This feast invites us to reflect on our deep connectedness as a community of faith — not only within our parish, our archdiocese, or our country, but across the entire world. I am continually inspired by the generosity and dedication of so many who give their time, talent, and hearts to serve others. This past week, as we celebrated our beautiful Masses for the faithful departed, countless people worked quietly behind the scenes to make those liturgies moments of healing and grace. I also remember with gratitude all the volunteers who have served this parish over the years and have now gone to their eternal rest. Their love and service continue to live on — our parish itself stands as a living memorial to them.

Finally, I ask you to spare a thought for those who may be feeling lonely or isolated this week — especially our young people. A simple word, a kind gesture, or a listening ear can make a world of difference. Let us continue to be a community that notices, reaches
